On January 12, 2011, a 7.0 earthquake struck Haiti and devastated Port-au-Prince killing over 220,000 people. The epicenter of the quake was Lagoane. It has been over a year since the quake, there has been some but not much progress has been made to restore the lives of the Haitian people.

A group of men will partner with [Hosean International Ministries](#), a supporter of Jerusalem Baptist Church in Pignon, Haiti.

During the week, the team will serve alongside Haitians doing the following activities: 1) helping to improve local infrastructure by constructing housing for displaced families; and, 2) participating in a men's fraternity with area churches to partner together for accountability and encouragement.
